Ventures Only Option 1

Ventures Only Option 2

Camp and cook in your own site at Lake Tioriti with no assistance or adult guests. Saturday hike 20 miles by yourself*, through rugged Harriman Landscape – explore mines, creeks, cliffs, lakes and vistas along the way. Sunday explore Cranberry Mine
