- Badger Building: Yes, the Roundtable Knights should have built a Badger instead of a Giant Rabbit – Each Patrol/Den will take turns constructing this wheeled war machine using their Pioneering Skills!
- Burning at the Stake: This will be a timed fire building challenge, without using matches. Which Patrol/Den will have the best time burning the Witch Scarecrow!
- Bridge of Death Compass: After various checkpoints, this wilderness course will lead you to the famous bridge. Will you be able to answer the 3 questions to cross safely? Or will the Black Knight end your days!
- Grail Course: Using teamwork and ingenuity, solve the many obstacles as the 3 Headed Knight directs your quest!
- Archery Range: Test your Knight's archery skills and see which Patrol/Den has the best marksman!
- French Castle: Yes! You will be insulted with various farm animals being catapulted at you. But you also have catapults to shoot back!
