Bear Grylls and his team will train and challenge each patrol

- Antarctica** You are air lifted to Vinson Asser, the coldest place on the earth. You have no matches but must build a fire before you freeze.
- Amazon** Your plane has crashed and after days of traveling in the jungle you are able to find plenty of food. But you have no utensils and must come up with ways to cook food to survive.
- Madagascar** Miles from nowhere two members of your crew take a bad fall down a gully. Without a real first aid kit, you must administer wilderness first aid and save their lives.
- Tanzania** Trapped in the savanna for days, you have found some shade and make camp. But you need to find or make water to survive.
- Siberia** Besides the polar bears you are faced with eerie sounds and movements in the snow. Can it be a snow monster? You are equipped tomahawks, walnut launchers and blow darts with which to protect yourself.
- New Zealand** As part of the training you must build a pioneering ultimate obstacle course; straddle, crawl, climb, swing and roll. You can try out what you build and complete against other patrols when finished.
- Banff** High in the Canadian Rockies you join cryptozoologist as you stalk mysterious creatures with action challenges thrown in. To escape its man vs. wild meets monster quest.
