



Troop 84 Boston Trip



When: **Friday November 18th to Sunday November 20th, 2011**

Highlights: **Spend two days sightseeing the historic town of Boston and vicinity!**

After a good night's sleep in a heated cabin, on Saturday we'll begin our city tour at the **Bunker Hill Monument and Museum**, including the 294 step climb to the top of the monument for an amazing vista of Boston Harbor. Next, we'll board our privately chartered **Super Duck Tour** vehicle, taking a 90 minute narrated tour around the city, both on land and from within Boston Harbor! Following lunch, we'll venture over to the **USS Constitution**, Old Ironsides, the world's oldest warship still afloat, for a tour given by active duty sailors.

The **New England Aquarium** is our next stop, to see electric eels, sting rays, sharks, penguins, seals and other amazing marine life. Here, we will also view an **IMAX movie, Sharks-3D**. Afterwards, dinner at the historic and incredible **Quincy Market** food court! Then we'll drive a short way to Foxboro's Patriots' Place, a huge entertainment complex that is also home to Tom Brady and the New England Patriots. Scouts and adults have their choice of visiting either **The HALL**, a fun, interactive experience and tribute to NFL football and the Patriots or **5-Wits' Espionage**, a high tech full immersion adventure.

Sunday morning we'll drive to the **Minute Man National Historic Park** in Lexington/Concord, MA. An award winning, multimedia theater program will give us an excellent introduction to the historic events of April 19, 1775, when Paul Revere rode out of Boston to warn that "The British are Coming!" Hike on **Battle Road** where the British regulars marched and were harassed by the colonists. See where Paul Revere was captured. Stand on **Concord's North Bridge** where the opening salvo of the American Revolution took place, the "Shot Heard Round the World".
