When: Sunday, August 2nd to Saturday, August 8th 2009

Where: Camp Bell, Griswold Scout Reservation
Gilmanton Iron Works, New Hampshire

Locale: 30 miles North of Concord and just South of Lake Winnepesaukee

3,500 acres of lakes, streams, springs, swamps, caves and mountains on the shore of Lake Manning.

Meals: Patrols pick their own daily menus and cook it themselves.

Campsite: Beautiful mountainside campsite of our own with platform wall tents and cots, modern outhouses with running water and showers.

Program: In the spring, patrols will be given a list of 24 activities to choose from. They will decide on 6 and then the camp reduces that down to 4.

Program areas include: Logging Camp, The Stables, Aquatics, Foxfire, Search and Rescue, Mountain Man and Challenge Valley. See attached information for more details

First year scout will also participate in the Brownsea program which will cover all First Class Scouting Skills.

Outpost Camping :: One night backpack with the Troop to a pristine, secluded Pond or Mountain Top - See and experience the real valley!

Venture Option for 14+ year old Scouts (Hawks, Cobras, Panther & Dragons):
