

Summer Camp Health Information

Please complete the following as soon as possible for each scout and/or leader attending summer camp this year:

1. Dietary Requirements and Medical Treatment Form
2. BSA's Annual Medical Form
3. Copy of scout or leader's Insurance Card (front and back). If your insurance requires a separate prescription card, please also make a copy of that card.

Explanation of forms:

1. Dietary Requirements and Medical Treatment form - This form is primarily for use by our Troop's medical designee to facilitate menu planning and to aid her/him in consultation with the Camp Nurse in the proper treatment of your child's medical conditions or emergencies. ***We would like this form returned with your initial registration materials and deposit on March 1st.*** You may be asked to update the form just prior to camp should there be any changes in the scout or leader's dietary or medical needs.

2. BSA's Annual Medical Form - NEW THIS YEAR - All scouts and leaders must have had a physical exam within 12 months of Summer Camp 2010. All scouts and leaders must submit a completed Annual Medical Form to the troop ***by June 7th***. These forms must be mailed by the troop to the camp well in advance of our arrival. *Scouts and Leaders without valid medical forms will not be admitted to the camp.* Please be sure to fill in all sections of the form. The doctor must complete Part B.

To access the BSA Annual Medical Form, go to our troop website www.troop84online.org and click on "Forms and Documents". Then click on "BSA Medical Form". That will bring you to a form that can be filled out and saved on your computer, or printed and filled out by hand. Since this medical form will need to be updated annually, you might find it easier to fill out the form on your computer and save it for reuse/editing next year.

You are responsible for filling out Part A and Part C. The doctor must complete Part B. Thus, you will need to print out the form to take with you to the doctor's office. The same form is used by adult leaders. The original doctor-signed 3-part form should be submitted to the troop no later than June 7th. Please make a copy for your own records.

3. Copy of Insurance Card (and Prescription Card if applicable) - The camp and troop require a copy of the scout or leader's insurance cards to facilitate treatment should your child need off-site medical care. Should your child require treatment, *you will be contacted*; however, having the insurance information greatly speeds up the paperwork part of the process, and thus, the care that will be offered. ***Please submit the insurance/prescription card copy along with the Annual Medical Form.***
