Hidden Valley



When: Sunday, August 1st to Saturday, August 7th 2010

Where: Hidden Valley, Griswold Scout Reservation
Gilmanton Iron Works, New Hampshire

Locale: 30 miles North of Concord and just South of Lake Winnepesaukee

3,500 acres of lakes, streams, springs, swamps, caves and mountains on the shore of Lake Manning.

Meals: All meals are served in a Dining Hall.

Campsite: Beautiful mountainside campsite of our own with platform wall tents and cots, modern outhouses with running water and showers.

Program: Morning Program :

- 1st Yr Scouts : Spend 2 hours every morning learning 1st Class skills, then take 1 easy & fun merit badge
- Other Scouts : Take 2 to 3 merit badges in the morning (your choice)

Afternoon Program :

ALL SCOUTS : Pick activities such as: swimming, rowing, archery, snorkeling, exploring, handicrafts, canoeing, kayaking, assault boats, rifle/shotgun shooting and sailing. Older scouts have option to take afternoon C.O.P.E.

Outpost Adventure :

One night our entire Troop will trek up to Mt Shannon for an outpost meal and a bivouac under the stars.

Venture Options for 14+ year old Scouts (Ravens, Hawks, Cobras, Panthers)

- Valley Voyageur: High Adventure - Scouts can opt for a backpack trek for the full week with rock climbing, navigating, caving, swimming and kayaking. See detailed info sheet.
- Spoke Option: High Adventure Light – Scouts spend 3 days out of camp with mountain biking, kayaking, rock climbing and one day in camp. See detailed info sheet.
