- * Buddy System/Buddy boat and Buddy Adult will be strictly enforced.
- * All Scouts are 14 and above
- * All Scouts have whitewater and boating experience
- * Ratio of 4 Scouts to 1 experienced adult leader
- * All Scouts have Safety Afloat and Safe Swim
- * Detailed safety will be gone over before each float
